JUBILATE DEO, OMNIS TERRA (*PSALM 100*)

- 1 O be joyful in the Lord all ye lands *

- 16 O Ananias, Azariah, and Misael, bless ye the Lord: *

Govern them and lift them up for ever.
- 14 Day by day we magnify thee, *
And we worship thy Name ever world without end.
- 15 Vouchsafe O Lord to keep us this day without sin. *

- 16 O Lord let thy mercy be upon us as our trust is in thee. *
O Lord in thee have I trusted;
let me never be confounded.
